(World Health Organization) announced Feb 10<sup>th</sup> as the National De-worming Day in India? (While this term is something that readers in the U.S. may not be aware of, it is of vital necessity in tropical nations.) Of course, all the HOINA children are de-wormed annually.

Our General Manager Anand was able to organize a medical camp for all the children recently. We had a team of ophthalmologists, dentists, a general physician, and support staff come from the

renowned Visakha Eye Hospital. Basic health screenings were completed and blood samples taken. We are waiting on the results for the samples. We have four children who were shortlisted for a detailed eye examination and will possibly need eyeglasses. Most of the children are in fine health. We have a couple of girls who were advised to get ultrasound scans. One of them might have a gynecological issue, and another is struggling with stomach issues. They are being kept under close observation, with changes in her diet and hydration hoping to heal the one girl's digestive trouble. Hopefully, these are just fixable issues and nothing more than that. HOINA is grateful to the team of doctors who came and did this camp, and all the staff who helped with this project.

You can be sure that if children are involved issues of some kind always crop up. Life is not always a bed of roses, but as long as the environment is stable most things can be worked out. A good home is a blessing, and so is the unparalleled gift of good health. HOINA gives that gift to our children, so they can have a healthy lifestyle. A healthy child is a happy child. Thank you, for partnering with HOINA to raise healthy, happy HOINA kids.

Sahithya, (right), who came to HOINA during the pandemic. Their father worked as a helper to a truck driver. Around 2018, both the children's parents started to have multiple health issues as a result of HIV. Eventually, the children were sent to their aunt's place. Since she was unable to care for her own, let alone adding her sister's children to her burden, she had to find some help.





Yashwanth and Sahithya's journey with the HOINA family began when their aunt brought them to us. Today Yashwanth is 10 and Sahithya, 12. They have weathered the pandemic on our campus, together, with their new HOINA brothers and sisters.
