They put on a show for me and insisted I sit in a simple plastic chair right under the only fan in the room.

The girls performed songs and dances: it was just a beautiful experience. I brought them chocolate candies as a treat. I also enjoyed eating a meal with the girls in the midst of their joyful chatter.

"When I got back to my hotel in Chennai, I remember I called my wife Cindy. I was completely drained and very emotional. I felt so honored by the girls and so humbled by the whole experience. Cindy and I have supported the progress of HOINA since then."

Todd and I have known the Benteles since our first move to Missouri in 1992. Our history with their family has shown us Randy's trustworthiness and abilities, which led to his invitation to serve on the HOINA board.

...the financial and treasury activities for HOINA are now being handled in Missouri. With this change comes a new PO Box for sending your financial support.




